The Training and Placement Cell facilitates the process of placement of students graduating from the institute besides collaborating with leading organizations in setting up internship programs for the students. The Cell provides the infrastructural facilities to conduct preplacement talks, online and written aptitude tests, group discussions, interviews besides catering to the hospitality of industry officials while on campus.

TRAININGS

• Training and Placement Cell conducted online FirstNaukri Aptitude test for all Third year students of Don Bosco College of Engineering. Also a coding test was conducted which was compulsory for Computer students and rest branches interested students could participle. Aptitude test was conducted online on 15th February 2020 and online coding test was conducted on 17th February 2020. The aptitude test was taken by 118 students and 25 students participated for coding test.
