Unaiza also gave her insight to the talk and said, "Studies abroad is not just about your course, it's about your overall development". The objective of the talk was to help aspiring students in choosing the right branch of engineering and making them aware of the admission process at the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) for engineering colleges. The talk was conducted in Auditorium on 18th June 2022 from 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM. Ms. Christina Barretto, the moderator of the event gave a brief introduction of the purpose to the audience. Dr. Neena Panandikar, Principal welcomed all the guests to the event. Director, Fr. Kinley D'Cruz gave brief information about Salesian Society of Don Bosco and its founder. ALUMNI ACTIVITIES

- As part of the Alumni activity, a webinar on 'Cardiovascular Health Analysis Using Physiological Signals and Machine Learning' was held in online mode to enlighten the students on recent research in biomedical engineering. The webinar was held on the 07th January 2022 at 2pm on google meet platform. The resource person invited to deliver the talk was Ms. Nidhi Sawant, Alumna who is currently a PhD scholar at NIT Goa. The audience comprised of second year and third year ETC students at Don Bosco College of Engineering. Ms Nidhi commenced the session by giving a brief introduction to what biomedical signal processing and its applications. She explained that her research involved combination of signal processing and machine learning. She briefly touched upon the flowchart of how heart sound signal analysis is carried out and how the classification is made of whether the heart condition is normal or not. The event was very well received by all and students had an opportunity to learn about the biomedical field.
